No information is held on cash savings achieved.

3. The 55% and 41% reductions are based upon casualty data, for the core fixed and core mobile cameras only, for the three years ending March 2010 compared to the baseline data. An excel spreadsheet displaying this is on our website. It has since come to our attention that there was an omission of one KSI casualty in the original calculation, making a variance of 0.2%, so the percentage changes should now read 54% and 41% respectively.

If you are dissatisfied with the handling procedures or the decision made by Hampshire Constabulary, you can lodge a complaint with the force to have the decision reviewed within 2 months of the date of this response.
